



# A Lesson in Obedience

# Blindfolded Maze Game Teaches Obedience

## Materials Needed:

- Blindfold
- Printable Maze
- Pencil or Pen
- Scissors or Paper Cutter

## Bible Verse:

*“Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it.” – Luke 11:28*

## Teaching Concept:

A loving God and loving parents create rules that benefit us and those around us. Kids do not have as much life experience as adults. To an even greater scale, we have a very small perspective compared to God’s view on life. The blindfold represents us needing a guide. We need to be quiet and really listen to know the instructions. When we listen to the voice leading us, we stay on the right path. In contrast, when we don’t listen or move too rashly, we fall off the path that leads to success in life.

## How to play

Print out the printable and cut to size. One person will be giving instructions. The other person will be trying to complete the maze. Blindfold the child who will be attempting the maze within the lines. Manually move their hand to the starting point. Begin giving voice commands to lead them through the maze successfully. As you do this, talk through the main concepts highlighted above.
