The hope of this video will be to spur you on to continue with this challenge for the next 3 months and hopefully to encourage others who have not yet joined the challenge, to join as well.

Structure of the Meet Up:

It can range from informal dialogues, where you share your struggles, challenges and even your prayer points to a more formal structure. Regardless the structure, the goal is to allow God to use your friend to speak truth into your life and be transformed into the image of Christ.
